

## NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that sealed bids will be received until the hour of 2:00 p.m. local time, Tuesday, November 27, 2018, at the office of the Coastside County Water District, 766 Main Street, Half Moon Bay, California 94019, for the 2 Inch El Granada Pipeline Replacement Project. Such bids will be opened publicly and read aloud.

This Public Works Contract consists of, in general, of constructing 300 feet of 6 inch diameter pipelines, abandonment of existing pipelines, replacement of 2 customer water service connections, reconnection of 7 customer water service connections, and asphalt concrete repaving. The site of the work is the unincorporated area of El Granada, San Mateo County, CA. All work is within existing street right of way areas.

The Engineer's estimate of the construction cost is \$110,000.

Bidders will be required to satisfy the mandatory minimum experience requirements set forth in Special Provisions Paragraph SP2.16: Responsibility of Bidders.

Bid documents consisting of the Contract Forms, Conditions of the Contract, Standard Specifications, Standard Details and the Contract Drawings may be examined and purchased at the District Office. The purchase price is \$25.00 and is nonrefundable. An additional \$25.00 will be charged for mailing each set of the documents via the U. S. Postal Service, or bidders may arrange for bidder-paid delivery by private delivery services such as FedEx. All bids must be on the prescribed forms. The telephone number of the District Office is (650)726-4405.

Each bid must be enclosed in a sealed envelope addressed to the Board of Directors of the Coastside County Water District and marked on the outside:

"Bid for the 2 Inch El Granada Pipeline  
Replacement Project"  
Coastside County Water District  
Half Moon Bay, CA"

Each bid must be accompanied by a certified or cashier's check or by a corporate surety bond on the form furnished by the District as a guaranty that the bidder, will, if an award is made to him in accordance with the terms of his bid, promptly secure worker's compensation and employer's liability insurance, public liability insurance, and execute a contract in the required form; and furnish satisfactory performance and payment bonds. Said check or bidder's bond shall be in an amount not less than 10 percent of the amount of his bid. Pursuant to Public Contract Code Section 22300, the successful bidder shall be entitled to submit securities in lieu of the retention of progress payments (See Section G9.09 of these General Conditions of these Contract Documents).

Bidders and their proposed subcontractors shall hold such licenses as may be required by the laws of the State of California for the performance of the work specified in the Contract Documents. Bidders bidding as the prime Contractor shall possess a valid California Contractor's "A" License at the time of Contract award, and additionally shall meet the requirements contained in the Contract Documents.

The District reserves the right at its sole discretion after opening bids to waive any and all irregularities in any bid, and to make award to the lowest responsible bidder, and to reject any and all bids.

This is a Public Works Contract. The attention of bidders is directed to the applicable federal and state requirements and conditions of employment to be observed and minimum wage rates to be paid under the Contract. Pursuant to Section 1773 of the Labor Code, the Department of Industrial Relations has established prevailing rates of per diem wages and general prevailing rates for holiday and overtime work in the locality in which the work called for by this Contract is to be performed for each craft, classification, or type of worker needed to execute this Contract.
