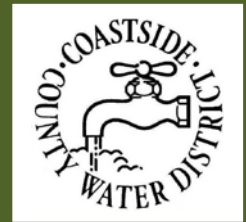

Half Moon Bay Pipeline Replacement Project

Coastside County Water District

Coastside County Water District will be making water system improvements from November 27, 2017 through February 2018 in Half Moon Bay. The District is replacing water distribution infrastructure in and around the downtown area.

Summary of Pipeline Replacement Project

- Replace 2,720 Linear Feet of Pipeline
- Install 15 New Valves
- Install 3 New Fire Hydrants
- Replace 1 Existing Fire Hydrant
- Install 15 New Valve Boxes
- Install 3 New Blow off Valves
- Replace 34 Meter Boxes
- Reconnect 56 Water Services
- Repave 9,100 square feet of Roadway

(weather permitting)

What to expect during construction:

- Noise, vibration, dust, parking and traffic impacts in work zones and disruption to normal neighborhood activity.
- Residents in the work zone will have access to all driveways.
- A short interruption of water service when crews are making water service connections to new pipe.

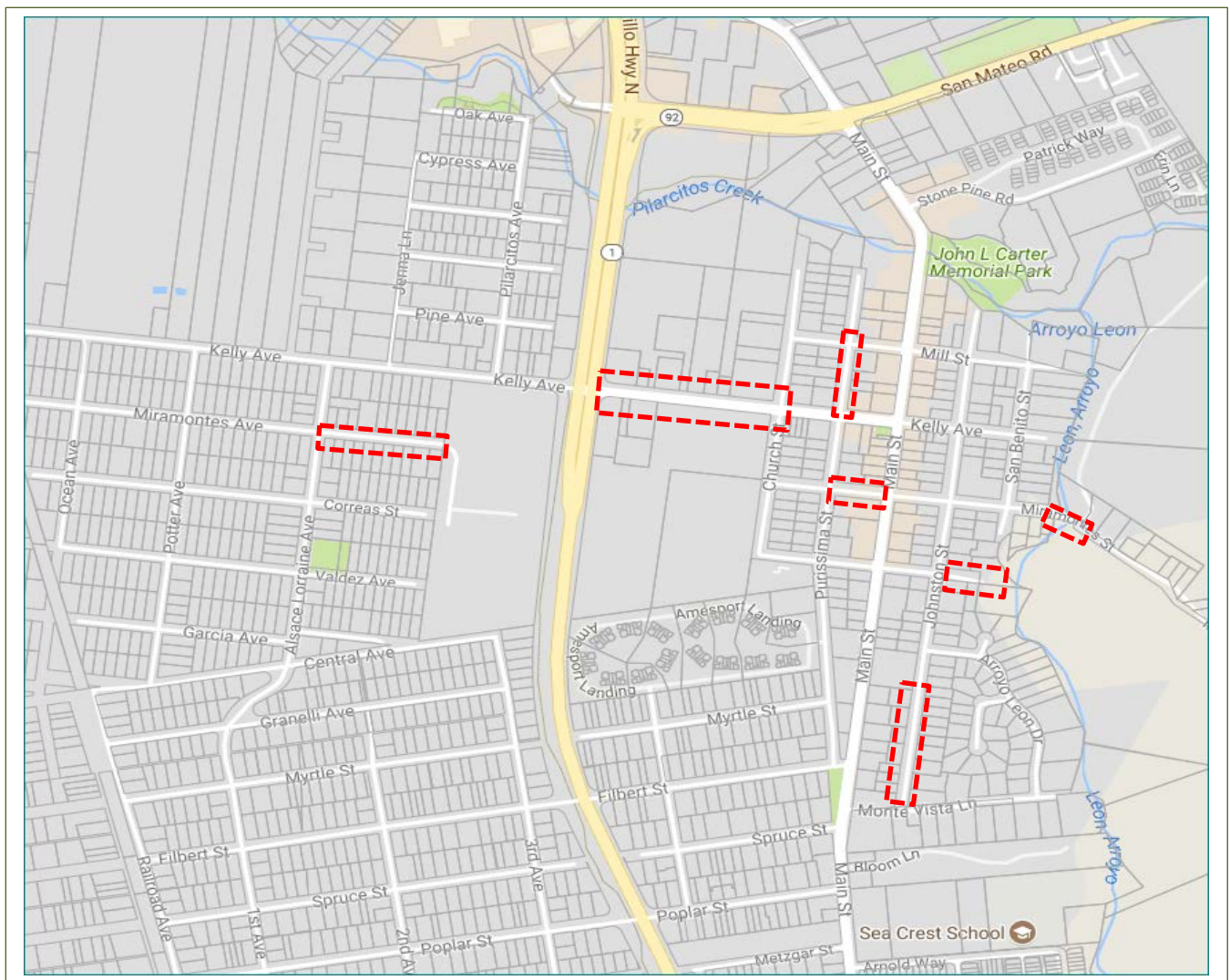
