Recommendation/Motion:

Ratify an amendment to the professional services agreement with Overland, Pacific, and Cutler, LLC for right-of-way acquisition services for the Highway 92 Potable Water Pipeline Emergency Restoration and Phase 1 Pipeline Replacement Project for a not-to-exceed budget of an additional \$27,300.

Background:

At the April 11, 2023 Board of Directors Meeting, the Board authorized the General Manager to enter into a professional services agreement with Overland, Pacific and Cutler, LLC. ("OPC") for right-of-way acquisition services for the Highway 92 Potable Water Pipeline Emergency Restoration and Phase 1 Pipeline Replacement Project for a not-to-exceed budget of \$61,700.

The project now requires an expanded scope of right of way acquisition services for an additional budget of \$27,300, for a total new not-to-exceed amount of \$89,000.

Given urgency to continue OPC's work in August 2023, the General Manager consulted with Legal Counsel and the Board President and Vice-President to authorize the amendment and to ratify it at the next Board of Director's meeting.

Authorize the General Manager to enter into amendments to the professional services agreements with EKI Environment & Water, Inc. LLC for land acquisition support services for the Highway 92 Potable Water Pipeline Emergency Restoration and Phase 1 Pipeline Replacement Project for a not-to-exceed budget of an additional \$36,000.

Background:

At the March 14, 2023 Board of Directors Meeting, the Board authorized the General Manager to enter into a professional services agreement for engineering services for the Highway 92 Potable Water Pipeline Emergency Restoration Project for a not-to-exceed budget of \$219,100. At the June 13, 2023 Board Meeting, the Board also authorized the General Manager to enter into a professional services agreement for engineering services for the Highway 92 Phase 1 Pipeline Replacement Project for a not-to-exceed budget of \$127,900.

The project now requires an expanded scope of land acquisition support services (included as part of the engineering services) for an additional budget of \$36,000 as follows:
