Recycled Water Feasibility Study Grant Money Received from the State Water Resources Control Board

In 2023, the District applied for a Recycled Water Feasibility Study Grant from the State Water Resource Control Board. Concurrently, the District engaged Water Works Engineers LLC ("Water Works") to conduct a study and prepare a report. The District's Board of Directors received the Water Works report at the September 10, 2024 Regular Board of Directors meeting. Cost incurred by the District for the study and report totaled \$184,762.

District staff submitted the report to the State Water Resources Control Board Recycled Water Funding Unit in Fall, 2024 and worked with State staff to address their comments and questions. The District recently received a check for \$87,500 as a grant for funding a portion of the study.

2025 SFPUC BAWSCA Emergency Exercise - October 16, 2025

On October 16 (on the day of the "Great Shakeout") SFPUC held a tabletop emergency exercise for BAWSCA water managers and their teams. The scenario for the exercise was: "At 7:45 am on October 16, a 6.5 magnitude earthquake strikes the SF Bay Area centered near the Hayward Fault." The focus of the exercise was to consider regional and water agency capabilities in the following areas: 1) initial alert and notification; 2) operational coordination; 3) customer communications and messaging; and 4) potable water distribution.

Approximately 50 staff members of 20+ agencies participated in the exercise. Mary Rogren, Jeffrey Schneider, Sean Donovan, and Darin Sturdivan participated in the exercise and represented the District.
