Monthly Highlights

- Mandatory pre-bid walk of Highway 92 Emergency Pipeline Replacement Project. Bid opening is scheduled for December 17.
- LeFevre Welding completed Denniston Contact Clarifier hatch fabrication and installation.
- Conducted pre-construction meeting with coating contractor, Euro Style Management on the Denniston Contact Clarifier/Coag/Filters coating project.
- Potholed PG&E lines at the Carter Hill tank site to determine if relocation of the PG&E lines is required.
- Conducted tree cleanup work in Pilarcitos Canyon after November storms.
- Coordinated brush removal at Denniston with Brush Hog Tree Care and District's biologist.
- Pump Repair Service installed and aligned motors on both washwater transfer pumps at Denniston.
- Substantial progress made on cleaning and painting of Nunes filter gallery piping.

 - Working on environmental permitting requirements and design for Pilarcitos culvert/slide repair and Pilarcitos well field potential well replacements.
