Ordinance Declaring a Water Shortage Emergency and Implementing Water Use Restrictions: Water Shortage Contingency Plan – Stage 2 Implementation

- Under California Water Code (CWC) Sections 350 – 359 and 31026-31029, Coastside County Water District’s Board of Directors has the authority to declare water shortage emergency conditions and shall thereupon adopt such regulations and restrictions in the delivery of water and the consumption of water within its area of water supply delivered.
- Notice of time and date of the public hearing shall be placed in the local newspaper at least seven days prior to the public hearing.
- **The proposed Ordinance Declaring a Water Shortage Emergency and Implementing Mandatory Water Use Restrictions will be available for public review on March 4, 2022, at 5:00pm on the District’s website.**
- **Public Comments:** The public will have the opportunity to protest the declaration of the water shortage emergency and to present their needs to the Board of Directors.
