Notice of Vacancy on the Board of Directors

Due to the resignation of Director Glenn Reynolds, a vacancy exists on the Board of Directors of the Coastside County Water District as of February 23, 2026.

Pursuant to Government Code Section 1780, a copy of this Notice of Vacancy is posted in three or more conspicuous places in the District, and it is also posted on the District's website, www.coastsidewater.org. Pursuant to that section, an appointment to fill the vacancy may be made by the Board of Directors fifteen (15) days after such posting.

If the Board fills the vacancy by appointment, the person appointed to fill the vacancy will hold office until the next general District election on November 3, 2026; and if the appointed Board member wishes to continue to be on the Board, they would be required to run for office in the November 3, 2026, election.

The District utilizes a zone-based election system and is divided into five geographic zones. Each Board member must reside in the zone they represent. Only voters residing within a specific zone are eligible to vote for that zone's Board seat.

Anyone interested in being appointed to serve on the Board is encouraged to submit a brief statement of interest and qualifications via email, mail, or hand delivery to the District no later than 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, March 25, 2026.

For this vacancy, eligible candidates must reside in, and be registered to vote in, Zone 1. The best way to determine if you reside in Zone 1 is to go to the District's website and use the interactive map. Please contact the District if you need assistance with the map.


